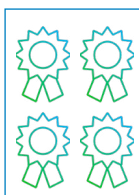
Award Submittals, anyone?

TRANSPORTATION PROFESSIONAL OF THE YEAR AWARD

TRANSPORTATION ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

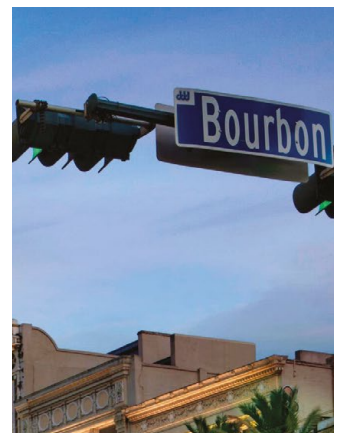
ITE Collegiate Traffic Bowl Grand Championship:
