The new Professional Development Record Keeping Systems allows all transportation professionals to maintain and track their credits more easily and effectively. The system is synced with the ITE Learning Hub. Credits earned through an ITE professional development opportunity will automatically show up in your record.

Permits the tracking of non-ITE professional development opportunities. (Current users should see note about the legacy system below.)

Provides totals of PDH and/or CM credits, making it easier to know where you stand regarding renewal for certification credits.

Creates customized transcripts to demonstrate completed credits for certifications, employers requests, or for state/provincial licensing.

Available FREE to ITE members. Non members can purchase a 3-year subscription for \$75.

For users of our older Record Keeping System, we plan to keep the legacy system available until 2024-2025. We are unable to migrate entries from the old system into our new Professional Record Keeping System. For a full explanation, please click below and see the "Update" section.
